**ENO Fine Wines
225 Westminster Street**

Located in Providence's historic Peerless Building, a Westminster Street commercial block recently rehabilitated by **Buff Chace** and **Cornish Associates**, ENO Fine Wines opened last year and has fulfilled the need for an upscale wine and spirits store downtown. Although a new store, ENO's interior demonstrates a reverence for historic structure and furnishings while maintaining a fresh sensibility. Owner **Jerold Ehrlich** purchased antique metal cabinetry and shelving salvaged from the Lackawanna County Courthouse in Pennsylvania to use as display racks for wine bottles. The space, designed with help from **Donald Powers Architects** and executed by **Case Construction**, maintains a constant temperature ideal for the wine. The thoughtful design and organization of the interior creates a lively, inviting space for casual browsers and connoisseurs alike.
